



Rules for the students of Acharyakulam

The Supreme Father, the supreme being, has established various rules and regulations for the Welfare and upliftment of living beings in the entire creation, which are also known as the laws of Ritu in the Vedas. The most important point in the whole world is discipline, and it is true, that with discipline the upliftment of children, and in turn, the nation is possible.

Only through discipline can physical, spiritual, social and economic advancement be achieved. The life as prescribed in the Vedas teaches to live a life of restraint and discipline, "Creation is in bondage", therefore consider rules and regulation not as restrictions but as the main foundation of your life.

The rules presented here are intended to further nurture, refine, and instill discipline in all students studying at Acharyakulam. These rules are essential for all registered students to follow.

1. The daily routine at Acharyakulam plays a crucial role in making students physically, mentally, and intellectually healthy, enabling them to become valuable individuals for themselves and society.
Note: All resident students must follow Acharyakulam's daily routine with devotion and discipline.
2. If any false information or facts provided by the guardians at the time of admission are later found to be incorrect, the Management of Acharyakulam will have the authority to expel or discipline the student accordingly.
3. All students are instructed to treat teachers and staff members with respect.
 1. They must maintain respectful behavior among themselves as well.
 2. Senior students should take care of younger students with love and affection, just like elder siblings, and offer them support.
4. Speech is the primary tool of interaction. Therefore, always ensure that improper language and inappropriate words are not used, even in casual discussions. Use the word Bhrataji and Bhaginiji.
5. All students must greet each other and their elders by saying "Om" (a respectful salutation). Whenever addressing someone by name, they must add "Ji" as a mark of respect.
6. The discipline and decorum of the institution must be maintained at all times. Any student engaging in unruly behavior will be subject to strict disciplinary action.
7. Students are instructed to respect the key symbolic elements of Vaidic culture, such as the Shikha (sacred tuft of hair), Yajnopavita (sacred thread), and Sutra (scriptures). They must also honour individuals who uphold these traditions and encourage others to follow them.
8. A formal head-shaving ceremony (Mundan Sanskar) is conducted for all newly admitted young students. Attendance at this cultural event is mandatory for all students.
9. All organized celebrations, yajnas (rituals), and discussions require full participation from all students. Students must be present in a calm and disciplined manner.
10. The holistic development of students is our primary goal. To achieve this, students are taught the importance of Yoga, Yajna, Ayurveda, and a sattvic (pure and nutritious) diet. We should follow a spiritual, indigenous, and virtuous lifestyle. Ideally, we would like parents to be aware of this matter as well.
11. It is mandatory to wear the designated school uniform (Ganavesh - Track Suit, T-Shirt, etc.) during Yoga, hevan, travel, classes, and playing sports.
12. Follow dress code regulations.

Dress Code:

Only appropriate clothing should be worn. Inappropriate clothing such as sleeveless clothes, short clothes, jeans, and clothes with inappropriate words printed on them are not acceptable. Only full-length shirts and trousers in black or navy blue are permitted. Both male and female students must wear traditional Indian attire and respectfully use the clothing provided by the institution.

13. "Pramado Mrityuh" (Negligence leads to death):
Laziness and negligence are considered the root cause of downfall. To achieve greatness, hard work is essential. Indiscipline, procrastination, and inactivity should be avoided. We must strive wholeheartedly for excellence, self-discipline, and productivity.
14. In the Acharyakulam premises, both inside and outside, raising hands on one another is a moral and serious offence. If a student is found involved in any kind of inappropriate, indecent, or unacceptable behavior, disputes, or physical fights, strict disciplinary action will be taken against them. In such cases, the student may also face expulsion from the school.
15. Even when there is no desire, one should not be lazy in performing worthy actions. Conversely, even if there is a desire, one should not engage in unworthy actions.
16. Follow the virtues of "Devi Sampad" as described in Chapter 16 of the Bhagavad Gita and never engage in the behavior of "Asuri Sampad" (negative qualities).
17. We are all children of God and are equal. Therefore, the use of any caste-based words (surnames) or any language that causes emotional harm is strictly prohibited. Discrimination based on region, language, attire, physical appearance, color, or any other factor is forbidden. Any conflict arising from such discrimination will lead to strict disciplinary action.
18. Be responsible in using natural and human-made resources.
 - 1) Do not misuse electricity or water.
 - 2) Always switch off lights, fans, and electrical appliances when leaving a room.
 - 3) Ensure doors and windows are properly shut before leaving.
 - 4) Consider it your ethical responsibility to follow these rules.
19. Bringing unauthorized electronic devices is strictly prohibited.
 - 1) Students must not bring or use mobile phones, cameras, recorders, video equipment, audio devices, digital watches, Bluetooth devices, etc.
 - 2) If found violating this rule, the items will be confiscated, and strict disciplinary action will be taken.
 - 3) Confiscated items will not be returned in the future.
20. Students must deposit restricted items before special events.
During excursions, special lectures, and cultural activities, students must submit their mobile phones and other restricted items at the designated time to the warden's office under their name.
21. During school activities, students must follow the chain of command.
Students must not directly approach authorities like the Principal, Head Boy, or Vedyas without prior permission from the designated authority.
22. Students are expected to uphold the spirit of nationalism and use only indigenous products.
Avoid misconduct during travel.
Students should behave with dignity and discipline during journeys and ensure that they do not engage in inappropriate actions that may bring disrepute to the school.
23. Stay informed through notice boards.
All students must regularly check the notice board in the Acharyakulam campus and hostel to stay updated with important announcements.
24. If you or your companion is suffering from any infectious disease, it is necessary to immediately inform the hostel warden. Any student should take care of their sick companion with cooperation and a sense of love.
25. Any student seeking suggestions can consult the hostel warden and receive guidance. Any appropriate suggestions can be forwarded to the Disciplinary Committee through the hostel warden for consideration.
26. The hostel's quiet environment will be maintained by hostel regulations. Each student will be provided with the necessary furniture, including a bed-box, pillow, table, chair, and cupboard.
27. Students will not be allowed to change their allocated hostel rooms except under special circumstances. The decision of the principal regarding the allocation of rooms will be final.
28. Students must contribute to keeping their classrooms, toilets, and both internal and external premises clean and beautiful. Writing on walls, putting up advertisements, posters, pictures, and cuttings is strictly prohibited.

29. Hanging belongings on the AC rod, tube light or curtain rod is strictly prohibited.
30. It is mandatory to student a gate pass to the security official at the gate officer obtaining permission from the principal to leave the hostel.
31. student are prohibited from entering any blocks, Floors, or rooms other than the once allotted to them without permission from hostel authorities
32. Student are not allowed to organize parties including birthday meetings make noise speak loudly argue or sing a financial fine of rupees 500/- will be imprested for violation there norms.
33. Students are expected to maintain discipline in the hostel and with fellow student. Any violation of discipline by students will be considered a serious offence in this regard, the evening attendance time is fixed at 9:00 pm student are expected to maintain silence during study hours 100% attendance of all student in the evening prayer is mandatory.
34. it is mandatory for all student to converses in Sanskrit and English during the des designated time.
35. At the time of entry into the acharyakulam premises, student belonging will be thoroughly checked by the designated officer
36. in case of any damage or loss of property in the Acharyakulam institution the responsibility for compensation will lie with the concern student or all selected students.
37. At acharyakulam premises, any room or students can be in inspected at any time as per the rules, and the cooperation of students is expected in such inspections.
38. The use of electrical appliances like kettles and irons is prohibited in the hostel rooms cooking of food is prohibited in students' rooms, Any violation will increase the fine
39. No property (chairs table etc.) is allowed to be taken into the bathing area, Disciplinary action will be taken by the hostel warden if belongings are left in the corridor causing disorder for shifting outside, only yoga mats should be used.
40. Wet/damp clothes should be dried only in designated areas,Do not hang them in public Palace or in public areas on doors, wardens, or near AC units, tube lights etc.
41. Student must inform the Warden/chief warden of any pleasant or unpleasant incidents.
42. Notice or general instruction will be displayed on the hostel notice board, and students are expected to follow them. Any changes to the rules will also be communicated through there notice.
43. Disciplinary action will be taken against student involved in group fights with him AcharyaKulam or in the hostel students are strictly prohibited from keeping any kind of weapons like sticks rods or hockey sticks with in the premises or hostel any violation will lead to strict disciplinary actions.
44. All students in the hostel must maintain peace and quiet respecting each other's study, rest and privacy, Any form of noise or disturbance is prohibited, students habitually cause disturbance or spread invest will be punished.
45. All students must use the designated areas and grounds for playing, playing in the hostel corridors rooms is strictly prohibited. Any sports equipment found in such areas will be confiscated and appropriate action will be taken.
46. Hostel authorities will conduct regular inspection of student's rooms.If any rooms is found dirty or disorganized, a fine and disciplinary reaction will be imposed students will also be encouraged to keep their room and hostel clean and orderly.
47. The hostel Warden and other teachers are like parents. Therefore, students should accept and respect all there instruction and guidance with positivity and seriousness.
48. If a student violets any disciplinary rules the discipline committee will impose appropriate penalties, which may include fine suspension, expulsion or other penalties. If a student does not adhere to the discipline, they may be expelled from the institution. In such cases No refund of any fees will be provided, and such students will not be issued a character certificate.
49. By signing blow, you knowledge that you have read and understand the institutional regulations of AcharyaKulam and agree to cooperate with and abide by them with full discretion and willingness. Only after providing your consent will you be allowed to feel out the return declaration form.
