



School Rule For Parents

General Rules

1. An Academic year permits boarders to go home for twenty (20) days in Mid-term vacation i.e. for Diwali and for 30 days for summer vacation. Further students of classes X and XII will be given 10 days mid-term vacation. Along with PCA Students of class XI. And 20 days for summer vacation.
2. In case of unavoidable circumstances or any emergency a student may be granted leave of maximum 5 days in an academic session with prior permission from the school Principal. A fine of Rs. 500 (Five hundred) per day will be imposed in case of absence from school without sanction of leave. If a student remains absent from school for 15 days or more at a stretch without written intimation to the Principal his/her name shall be struck off the admission Register.
3. An outing of 3 hours is permitted on the birthday of a student with prior permission from the Principal. Please ensure and confirm approval before planning the outing. Parents may join the morning haven on the birthday to bless the child.
4. No student will be allowed on campus after 7:00 pm by the hostel management, kindly adhere to the timings given to avoid any inconvenience. Whether returning from leave or Birthday outing.
5. For the emotional and psychological well-being of the students video call with the parents is permitted once every week for the students of class V and once in a fortnight for the students of classes VI to XII.
6. It is compulsory for the parents to attend the Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM) as per schedule given in the school calendar. Only parents or guardians authorized by the parents can meet their ward(s) in the campus with the approval of the Principal.
7. Parents are requested to send their inquires or orders for birthday sweet distribution via email at sweets@acharyakuam.org. Sweets can be ordered from the attached list. During the winter season, dry fruits and homemade sweets are allowed to be sent in small quantities preferably not more than one (1) kg.
8. Deductions will be made from the student's impressed account for the utility articles provided to them from time to time.
9. Discipline, decency and decorum should be maintained by each student. Any act of mischief, break of rules, disobedience or disloyalty to the institute by a student or parent can be considered as an act of indiscipline. The school reserves the right to expel a student on the grounds of misconduct, indiscipline or disregard of school rules and regulations.
10. Sanctions imposed for any kind of damage to the school property by a student will be charged to the students 'imprest Amount'. They can be penalized in case of reckless damage.

11. Electronic gadgets (smart watch, phone, laptop, I-pod etc.) costly articles and readymade eatables are not allowed to the students. Flouting of rules will lead to imposition of heavy penalties, issue of yellow card red card and the article will be confiscated.
12. An outing of 3 hours is permitted on the birthday of a student with prior permission from the Principal. Please ensure and confirm approval before planning the outing. Parents may join the morning haven on the birthday to bless the child.
13. Share any medical condition, allergies or other health related information with the hostel management.
14. Respond at the earliest to all the communications sent by the school.
15. Any change in the address or telephone or mobile number of the parents must be immediately informed by the parents to the school authority in writing.
16. Parents are expected to be present on the campus at the appointed time whenever called.
17. Parents not allowed to enter hostel rooms, if it is occupied.
18. The tonsure ceremony performed during the sacred thread ceremony for a new student is mandatory. Parent is expected to not only respect the symbol of Vaidic culture, such as the tuft and sacred thread, but also encourage others to adopt and wear them.
19. Upholding the spirit of nationalism, parents are expected to use only indigenous products.
20. To enhance creativity in students according to their interests whether in game, Yoga, music (vocal or instrumental) research, literary writing, painting or foreign languages - guidance will be provided. Deserving students will be felicitated and send to participate in inter school competitions.
21. The luggage of the students will be inspected by an authorized authority upon entry to the campus Banned items will not be allowed inside.
22. Parents will submit NOC and details (mode of travelling, place, timing, mobile details etc) of their wards, who are travelling alone to the Principal/Warden at the given mail id (info@acharyakulam.org).

23. **Uniform:**

- Hair: Girls with long hair should make a braid at all times.
Boys should have short hair which is above the shirt collar, above the ears and the fringe off the face. None should have artificially dyed or coloured. Hairlines should not be razored into the hairstyle. Boys are expected to maintain their *SHIKHA (tuft)*. All the students must wear *YAJOPAVIT* as per tradition.
- Jewellery: Students are advised not to wear expensive and sentimental jewellery as there is a risk of getting it lost and the school cannot be held responsible. One set of stud earrings should be worn by girls only.
Accessories of any Kinds are prohibited.
- Facial hair: All boys should come to school clean shaven. Students can be provided with limited number of casual dresses.

Communication among the parents an whatsapp groups need to be clarified with the management before talking any decision.
