



School Rules for Parents

General Rules

1. Boarder students of classes V to IX and XI shall be granted a 20-day mid-term vacation. (Diwali Break) and a 30-day summer vacation. Students of classes X and XII, along with PCA students of class XI, shall be granted a 15-day mid-term vacation (Diwali Break). PCA students of classes XI and XII shall be granted a 10-day summer vacation.
2. In case of unavoidable circumstances or any emergency, a student may be granted leave of maximum 5 days in an academic session with prior permission from the school Principal. A fine of Rs. 500 (Five hundred) per day will be imposed in case of absence from school without sanction of leave. If a student remains absent from school for 15 days or more at a stretch without written intimation to the Principal his/her name shall be struck off the admission Register.
3. An outing of 3 hours is permitted on the birthday of a student with prior permission from the Principal. Please ensure and confirm approval before planning the outing. Parents may join the morning *hawan* on the birthday to bless the child.
4. No student will be allowed entry to the campus after 7:00 pm by the hostel management. Kindly include this in the timings to avoid any inconvenience, whether returning from leave or Birthday outing.
5. For the emotional and psychological well-being of the students, call with the parents is permitted once every week for the new students and once in a fortnight for the remaining students.
6. It is compulsory for the parents to attend the Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM) as per schedule given in the school calendar. Only parents or guardians authorized by the parents can meet their ward(s) in the campus with the approval of the Principal on the 2nd Sunday of the month.
7. Parents are requested to send their inquiries or orders for birthday sweet distribution via email at ombeer.singh@acharyakulam.org Sweets can be ordered from the attached list. During the winter season, dry fruits in small quantities and homemade sweets preferably not more than one (1)kg are allowed to be sent.
8. Deductions will be made from the student's imprest account for the utility articles provided to the students from time to time.
9. Discipline, decency and decorum should be maintained by each student. Any act of mischief, break of rules, disobedience or disloyalty to the institute by a student or parent can be considered as an act of indiscipline. **Counselling of the student will be conducted on the first instance of a mistake. Repetition of the mistake will lead to an appropriate fine. A third instance will result in a fine and the issuance of a yellow card. Fourth instance may lead to expulsion from the school. The school reserves the right to expel a student on the grounds of misconduct, indiscipline or disregard of school rules and regulations.**
10. Sanctions imposed for any kind of damage to the school property by a student will be charged to the students 'imprest Amount'.
11. Electronic gadgets, (smart watch, phone, laptop, I-pod etc.) costly articles and readymade eatables are not allowed to the students. Flouting of rules will lead to the

imposition of heavy penalties, issue of yellow card, red card and the article will also be confiscated.

12. Share any medical condition, allergies or other health related information with the hostel management with proper document.
13. Respond at the earliest to all the communications sent by the school. Parents are expected to be present on the campus at the appointed time whenever called.
14. Any change in the address or telephone or mobile number of the parents must be immediately informed by the parents to the school authority in writing.
15. Parents are expected to be present on the campus at the appointed time whenever called.
16. Parents are not allowed to enter hostel rooms, if it is occupied.
17. The tonsure ceremony performed during the sacred thread ceremony for a new student is mandatory. Parent is expected to not only respect the symbol of Vaidic culture, such as the tuft and sacred thread, but also encourage others to adopt and wear them.
18. Upholding the spirit of nationalism, parents are expected to use only indigenous products.
19. To enhance creativity in students according to their interests whether in game, Yoga, music (vocal or instrumental) research, literary writing, painting or foreign languages - guidance will be provided. Deserving students will be felicitated and sent to participate in the inter school competitions.
20. The luggage of the students will be inspected by an authorized authority upon entry to the campus Banned items will not be allowed inside. Parents are expected to have the student's admission number and class written clearly on their belongings, such as clothes, blanket, trolley bag etc.
21. Parents will submit NOC and details (mode of travelling, place, timing, mobile details etc.) of their wards, who are travelling alone to the Principal/Warden at the given mail id (info@acharyakulam.org).

22. **Uniform:**

- Hair: Girls with long hair should make a braid at all the times.
Boys should have short hair which is above the shirt collar, above the ears and the fringe off the face. None should have artificially dyed or coloured. Hairlines should not be razored into the hairstyle. Boys are expected to maintain their *SHIKHA (tuft)*. All the students must wear *YAJOPAVIT* as per tradition.
- Jewellery: Students are advised not to wear expensive and sentimental jewellery as there is a risk of getting it lost and the school cannot be held responsible for such loss. One set of stud earrings should be worn by the girls only.
Accessories of any kind are prohibited.
- Facial hair: All boys should come to school clean shaven. Students can be provided with limited number of casual dresses.
Communication among the parents on whatsapp groups need to be clarified with the management before taking any decision.
